

### Thomas Samuel Warren

**20<sup>th</sup> February 1893** Born at 8 Station Road, Dagenham (now Chadwell Heath).  
He was second youngest son of James & Julia Eleanor Warren

**CENSUS 1911 taken on 2/3 April shows :-**

**1) Alfred & Amy(Warren)Kendrick** + their 2 sons and her sister **Ellen** & brothers **William & Thomas Samuel** are all living at 1, Progress House, High Street, Dagenham

**2) Miller Smith & family** have moved from London to Stoughton - a village on northern edge of Guildford. Two years later, their daughter, **Norah Lilian** meets **Thomas Samuel Warren** for the first time in the Wooden Bridge pub - still exists

**31<sup>st</sup> December 1913** Lilian Isabel Smith -actually **Norah Lilian (18)** marries **Thomas Samuel** at Parish Church, Wimbledon. He (21) is living at 6 Goldcroft, Yeovil, Somerset.

**25 May 1914 Iris Lilian (Biddy)** born at Ridgway Road, Stapleton, Bristol

**14<sup>th</sup> June 1915 Thomas Horace(Sonny)** born at 76 Church Lane, Charlton

**12 March 1917 Phyllis Poppy** born at 41 The Village, Charlton

**27 January 1919 Dennis Graeme (Denny)** born at 41 The Village, Charlton

**13 December 1920** per certificate (**Thomas) Horace** baptised at St Mary's in Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire

**3 March 1921 Violet Norah (Blue)** born at 3 Ardenham Lane, Aylesbury

**September 1925** Family lodging with **Miller Smith** at Mark Cross (nr Tunbridge Wells) and "**Blue**" remembers starting at the village Infants School. Later they moved off to Guildford

**4 October 1927 Beryl Molly** born at 15 Commercial Road, Guildford

**12 February 1932 Ronald** born at 'Old Erringham' Dorking Road, Great Bookham

**24 July 1933** Norah Lilians father, **Herbert Alfred (Miller) Smith (65)** dies at Middle House, Dorking Road, Epsom and certificate says he was living at **19 Greenways ??** Buried in unmarked paupers grave K514 Epsom Downs Cemetery

**4 January 1935 Trevor** born at **35 Greenways**, Wells Estate, Epsom Common

**15 April 1936** Norah Lilians mother **Henrietta (65)** - known as Yetta by her sisters & Granny Grizzle by her grandchildren - dies at 58 St Philips Avenue, Worcester Park. Her death is notified by her only son, **Alured Berkeley Hamilton Smith (33)** of 163 Church Lane, Charlton

**26 December 1938** Thomas Samuel does not attend his eldest son's wedding but

the Bride (May Edith Steel) tells me that Norah Lilian does as she is still living at Greenways on Wells Estate, Epsom

**1 June 1946 Norah Lilian Hamilton Warren** (50) dies suddenly and is cremated - she had been separated from Thomas for some years & her last address was as housekeeper at 78 Stanley Road, Croydon

**17 March 1947 Thomas Samuel** (54), now a widower for 9 months, marries his housekeeper, a Scottish born spinster called **Isabella Fraser** (31) at Epsom Register Office

**24 January 1948 Dennis Graeme Warren**(28) marries **Ada Georgina Cutts**(19) at Epsom Register Office

**24 July 1948 Beryl Molly Warren** (20) marries **Peter John Gilbert Pratt** (27) at Morden Register Office

**27 February 1954 Trevor Warren** (19) marries **Elsie Boddy** (21) at Epsom Register Office

**25 March 1957 Thomas Samuel Warren** (64) dies in St Barts Hospital, London and is buried in un-marked grave - plot S265 Epsom Downs Cemetery

**15 February 1958** eldest daughter **Iris Lilian (Biddy)** (43) dies in St Helier Hospital

**14 February 1962 Violet Norah (Blue) Rides** marries **Ray Karley** (37) at Epsom Register Office.

**20 August 1988 Dennis Graeme** (69) dies in Hobart, Tasmania

**16 August 1996 Thomas Horace** (81) dies in Epsom General Hospital & is cremated

**?? Date in 1998 Phyllis Poppy** dies in Adelaide, Australia

*The four younger children are all still alive :-*

**Violet (Blue)** is living in Avalon Beach, Sydney, Australia and sister **Beryl** lives a couple of doors away in the same street.

Sadly, **Blue's** husband **Ray Karley** died as recently as 17<sup>th</sup> July 2009 (he was 84) - **Beryl's** husband, Peter Pratt died in 1983

**Ronald** emigrated to Canada and still lives in the house he bought with wife June Turner in Ancaster in 1958.

**Trevor** lives close to the New South Wales / Queensland border having gone back to OZ (after returning to UK with wife Elsie & children and then getting divorced).
